Ass't. Sargent, George Mefford was drafted September 29 1917, and went to Camp Dix, was in the 307 th field artillery as stable orderly, there about ten months and left camp about twelve PM. was on boat at two AM. on the twenty sixth of April 1918. sailed on the Cedric for Liverpool, had a very rough voyse across, went to camp at Southampton, was there about three days then went across the Channel to a rest camp in France, was there three days and was taken by train to Demacon, was there four weeks and while there was sent out to pick up horses for the remount station at Cheatu, was there about six weeks, then went to the front, was in camp two days, was set back of Metz on the St. Mihiel sector, was there two weeks and traveled by night to the Aronne, was at Redon when the Armistice was signed and walked to Verdun, was there about five weeks, then to Quincy, was there untill the returning voyse which lasted thirteen days coming by way of Giberalter and the Azors to camp Dix, was discharged May 22 1919. Was in eight battles on three different fronts. The first battle of September 12 & 13 1918 was a very severe one, Our horses had been out thirty three hours without food and the battle lasted seventy two hours.

A biography of George Mefford's service in the military. Assistant Sergeant Mefford was drafted into the Army on September 29, 1917. He worked as a stable orderly and was discharged on May 22, 1919.
