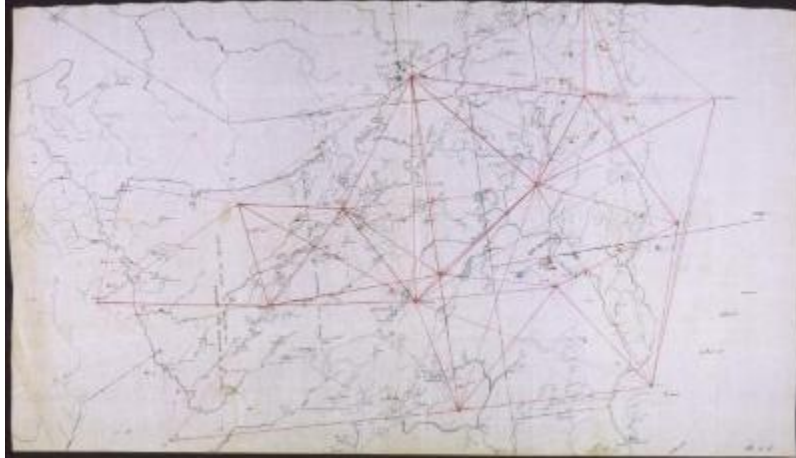


## Central Adirondack Triangulation Network Diagram with Primary Triangulation Station Names
