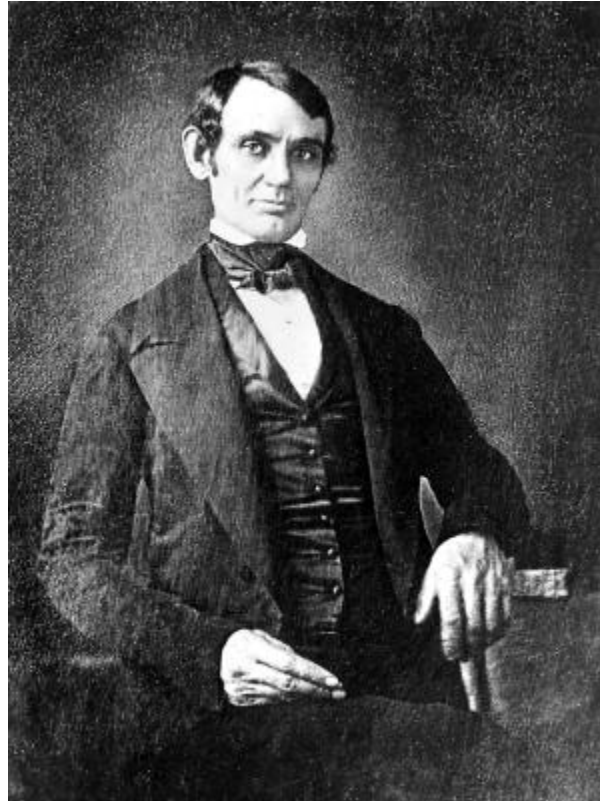


Abraham Lincoln. Earliest Known Portrait
