Notice. To the public, not to sell any beer or liquor to the Barent Ennesen aforesaid, during his confinement, neither to give him any credit, nor to employ him in any way. [1648] (page 396); Order. [1648] (page 396); Order to measure goods belonging to Gillis Verbrugge and Johannes Hardenburgh, in order to ascertain whether they agree with the invoices, as certain frauds have been discovered. [1648] (page 396); Second examination. Of Claes Bordingh, in regard to smuggling. [1648] (page 397); Examination of a Pasquaskeck Indian, as to where he got powder. [1648] (page 397); Resolution. To send the ship Love for a cargo of salt, and the commissary to Stamford to purchase provisions. [1648] (page 397); Permit. To Gillis Verbrugge, to sell his goods, the measurement being found correct. [1648] (page 397)
