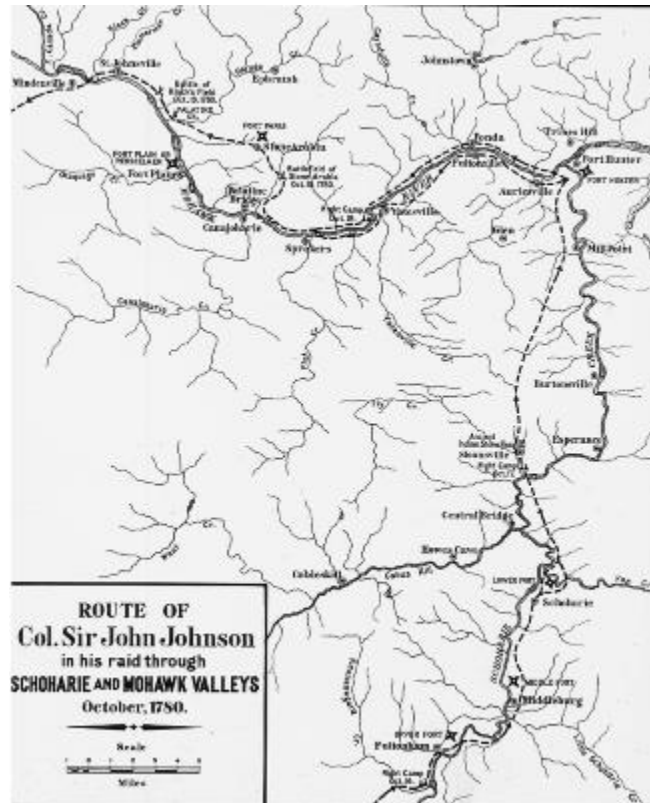


Route of Col. Sir John Johnson
