The map shows the greatest expansion of the Roman Empire under Emperor Trajan in 116 CE, as well as its major neighbors. The extent of the expansion is demarcated with dashed lines. The map also shows major cities of the era, such as Rome, Alexandria, Jerusalem, and Londinium (London), and gives the Latin names of the Caspian and Black Seas, n.d.

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
