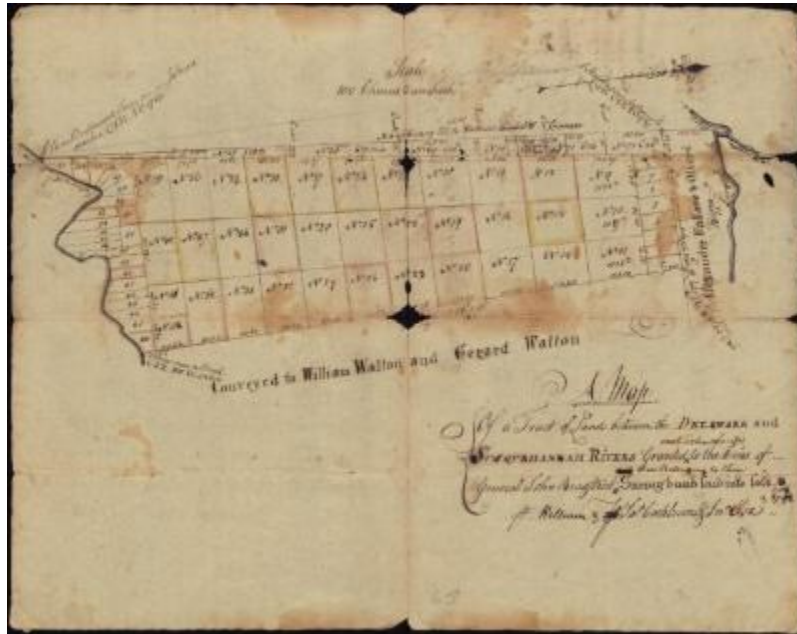


## A Map of Tract of Land between the Delaware and Susquehannah Rivers
