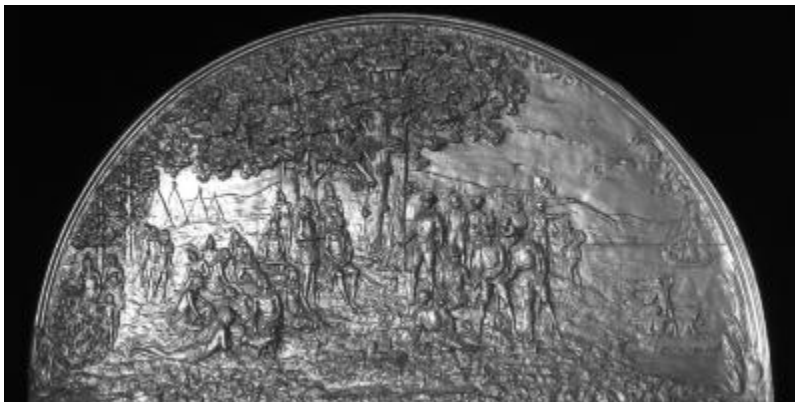


Hudson Trading with Manhattoes. Bronze in Capitol. Albany, N.Y.
