

## JOURNAL kept by Adriaen Blaes van der Veer, skipper of the slaver St. Jan



Journal. Ship St. John's voyage from El Mina to Rio Real for slaves, and thence to Curaçao ; 385 were shipped, but for want of provisions, 190 were sent to El Mina ; the ship was finally wrecked on the reefs of Rocco, near Bonaire, and the slaves abandoned ; 84 were afterwards captured by an English privateer or rover.
