

## Notice by John Van Benthuisen for a grant of land in Rhinebeck, 1791

Notice is hereby given that according to a law of  
the State, I am intended to apply to the Commissioners of  
the Land Office for a grant of the Land under the  
water of Hudson's River, to the channel hereof, oppo-  
site to my land in Rhinebeck Town & County  
of Dutchess, on said 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1791.  
John Van Benthuisen  
Dutchess County of Pennsylvania appeared before me Henry Livingston Jr.  
one of the Justices of the Peace for said County, John White also  
being Dutchess County Constable that the above Notification  
had been put up and remained for weeks on the outer  
Door of the Court house in the County of Dutchess on the 10<sup>th</sup> day  
of August 1791.
