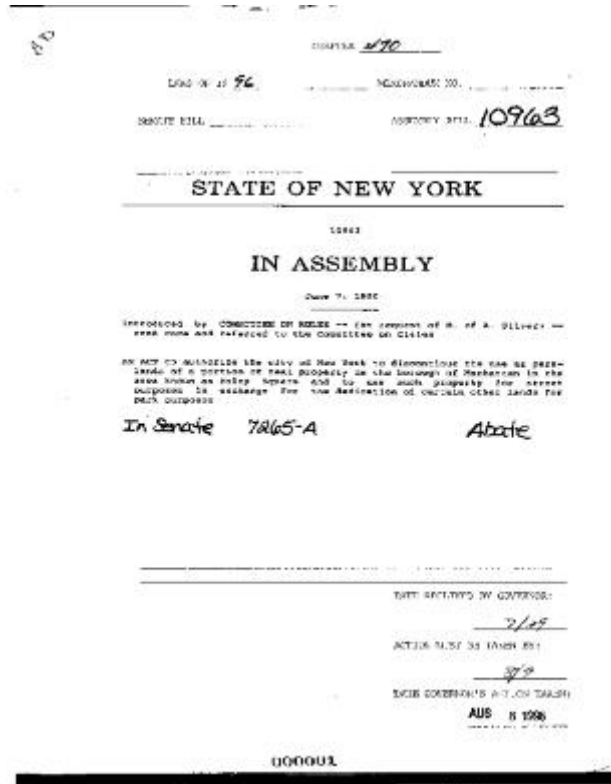


NYS Bill and Veto Jackets: 1996, Chapter 470
