
Map of a village laid out in the mile square in the St. Regis Reservation pursuant to the Act Chapter 194 passed April 1818

Map of a village on the Canadian border divided into numbered lots showing acreage, laid out on named streets, with survey notes about certain lots and surrounding land. Salmon and Little Salmon Rivers run through the village.
