

Done pursuant to instructions of Simeon DeWitt, Esq., Surveyor General of the State of New York and to whom this survey and map is respectfully inscribed by his much obliged friend. Signed by Peter Gifford, Deputy Surveyor and Simeon DeWitt, Surveyor General.
