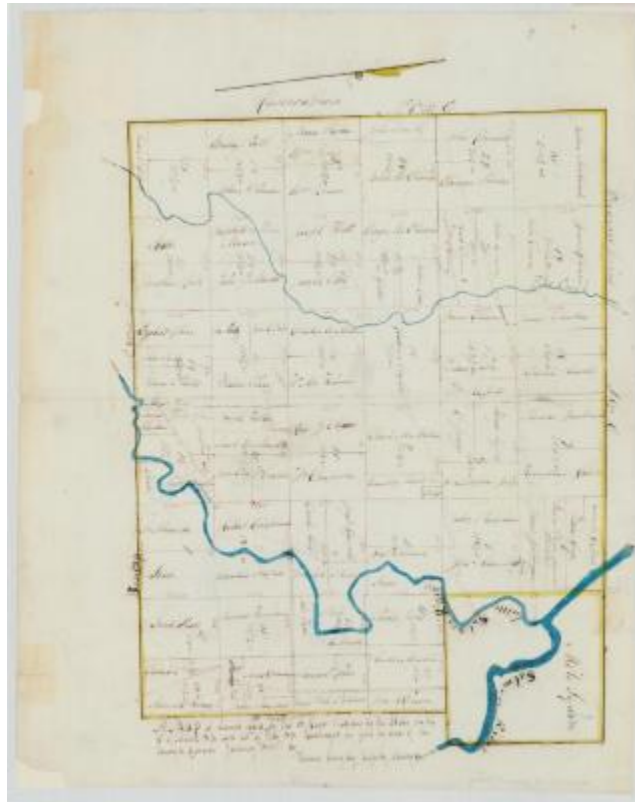


A map of lands ceded by the St. Regis Indians to the State of New York in 1816 and 1818

Map of land in lots showing acreage, landowners, Mile Square, Salmon and Little Salmon Rivers, and Pike Creek. The land is situated in Franklin county at Fort Covington. Original map size 20.5" x 16.5".

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
