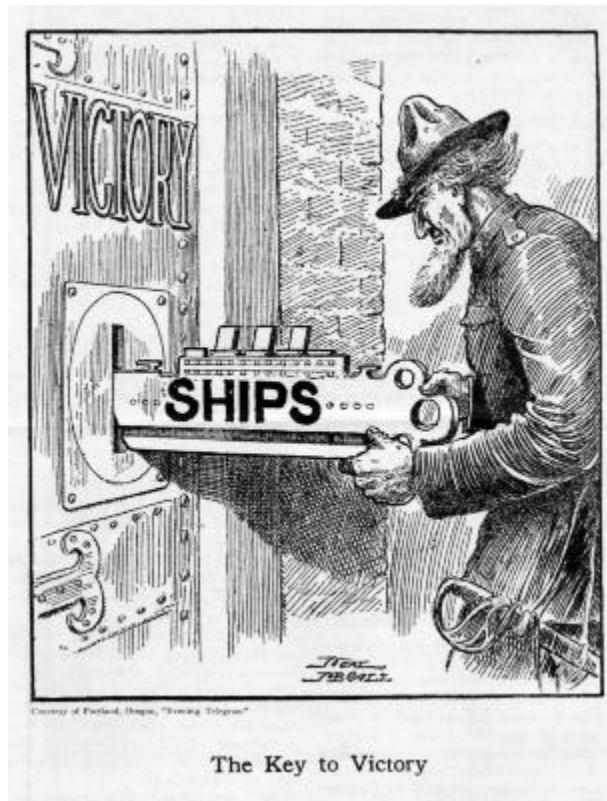


“The Key to Victory”
