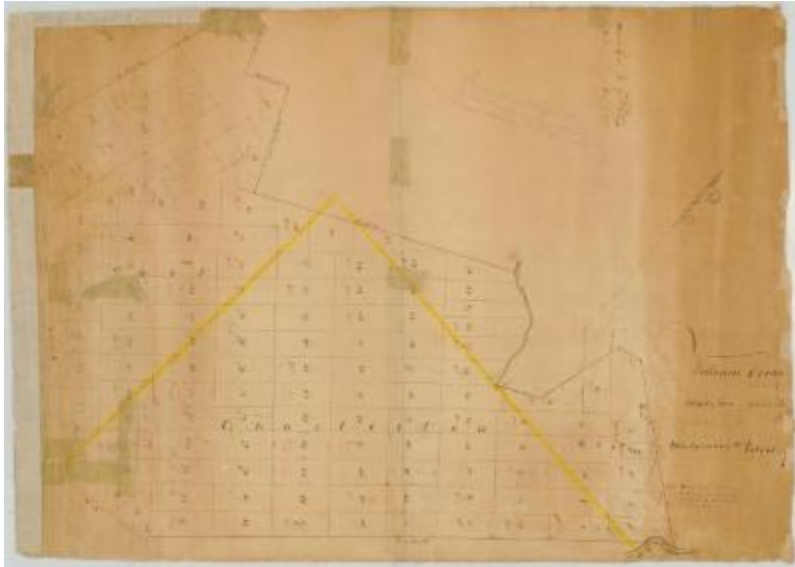


## Map of Correy's Patent



Map of Correy's Patent in Montgomery County and Schoharie county. The patent was awarded to William Corry [sic] and others in 1737. The map is composed of paper mounted on a linen backing. Adhesive tape had been used by the State Comptroller's Office to repair the map. This tape has been left in place.;The map was removed from its wooden mounting for scanning. It was placed in a protective polyester (Mylar) folder, so moirés (or Newton's rings) are present, particularly at the edge of the digital image.
