

**[Aerial photograph, flying across lower Manhattan, 09/15/2001]**



Aerial photograph, no. 3 in a sequence, taken by plane flying across lower Manhattan from southeast to northwest a few days after the September 11 terrorist attack upon the World Trade Center, on September 15, 2001. On this date, parts of the site were still on fire.;The building slightly above center is 6 World Trade Center (U.S. Customs House); note the large, dark hole in its roof. The footprint of 1 World Trade Center (North Tower) is immediately to its right. The footprint of 2 World Trade Center (South Tower) is immediately to the right and slightly below the footprint of 1 World Trade Center. Both footprints are obscured by plumes of smoke.;Magnify the center of this image to view bucket brigades of emergency personnel removing debris from the site.

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
