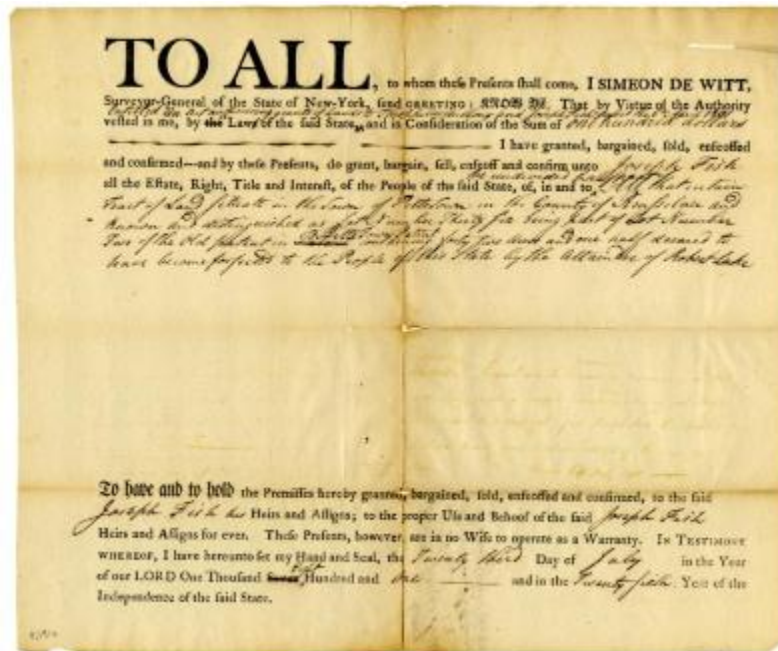


## Deed for property in Pittstown, 1801
