


Deposition by Robert Watts, 1809



State of New York for Robert Watts of the City and --
County of New York being duly sworn deposeth
and saith that he was well acquainted with
Robert Leake formerly of the City of New York
who died in the said City before the year one
thousand seven hundred and seventy four
that he always understood and believes that
he at his decease left two sons only to wit
Robert W Leake and John G Leake and
that the first named who married his
sister and has since died was
the eldest son and the heir at law of the
above named Robert Leake and that John
G Leake now resides in the City of New York
and further this deposition he
swore this sixth day
of March 1809 before me
A. Patterson
March 6 1809 Robert Watts

Deposition by Robert Watts in which he stated that he knew Robert Leake, and that Leake had died before the year 1774 in New York City leaving two sons, Robert W. Leake and John G. Leake. He also stated that Robert W. Leake was deceased and was married to Watts' sister.
