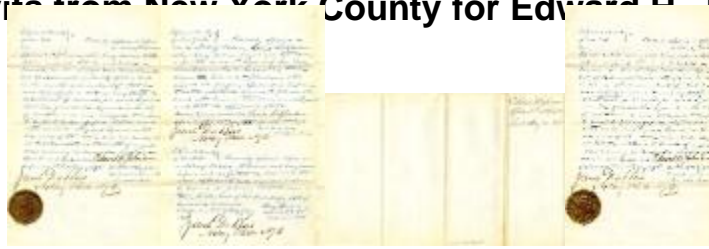


## Affidavits from New York County for Edward H. Johnson



Three affidavits: the first signed by Edward H. Johnson verifying his service in the First Regiment of New York Volunteers during the Mexican War; the second signed by Louis Sulzbacher verifying the service of Edward H. Johnson; the third signed by Henry Gains also verifying the service of Edward H. Johnson in the Mexican War. Affidavits each signed by notary public Jacob Du Bois.
