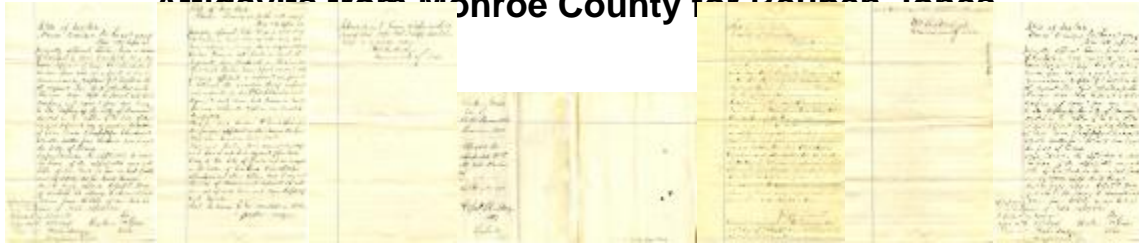


## Affidavits from Monroe County for Reuben Jones



Three affidavits: the first signed by Reuben Jones verifying his service in the First Regiment of New York Volunteers during the Mexican War and appointing Alfred Mudge as his attorney; the second and third signed by John Noyes and Joseph Roworth, respectively, verifying the service of Reuben Jones in the Mexican War. Affidavits each signed by the commissioner of deeds.
