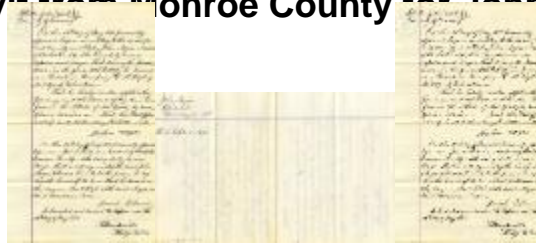


## Affidavit from Monroe County for John Noyes



Two affidavits: the first signed by John Noyes verifying his service in the First Regiment of New York Volunteers during the Mexican War and providing his address, indicating that he is applying for any bounty due to him for his service; the second signed by Josiah B. Davis verifying the service of John Noyes. Affidavits signed by the notary public.
