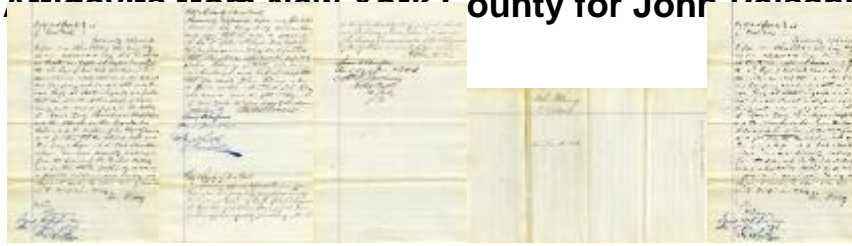


## Affidavits from New York County for John Pelsany
