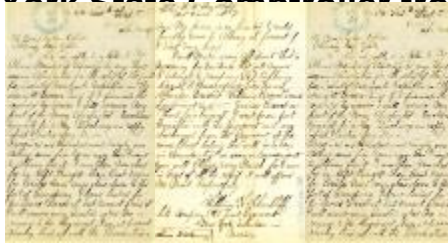


## Letter to the New York State Comptroller from William Shurtliff



Letter to the New York State Comptroller from William W. Shurtliff, veteran of the New York State Volunteers (G Company) during the Mexican War, who requested information about pension money owed to him, and also indicated his willingness to give more information or affidavits to prove his claim. He also indicated that a copy of his discharge certificate was included to go with his letter of application.
