Application for pension money from the New York State Comptroller's Office from the widow of John Meech, a veteran of the New York State Volunteers (I Company) during the Mexican War. Includes affidavit signed by Colonel Ward B. Burnett, Sarah A. Hollenbeck and Maria S. Dewey, in addition to proofs of marriage and death. Also included is authorization of Notary Publics Frederick M. Inglehart and George D. Emerson of Kings County (NY) by Kings County Clerk George L. Remington.
