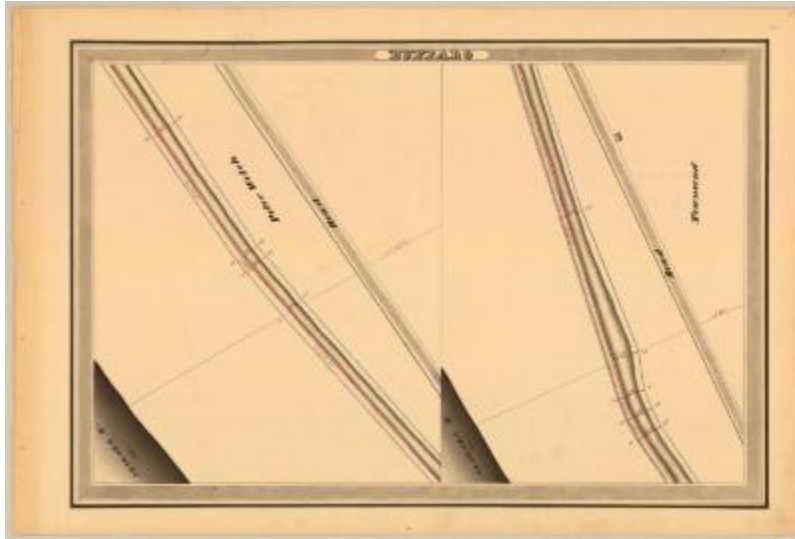


Erie Canal Survey, Buffalo showing Welch and Townsend
