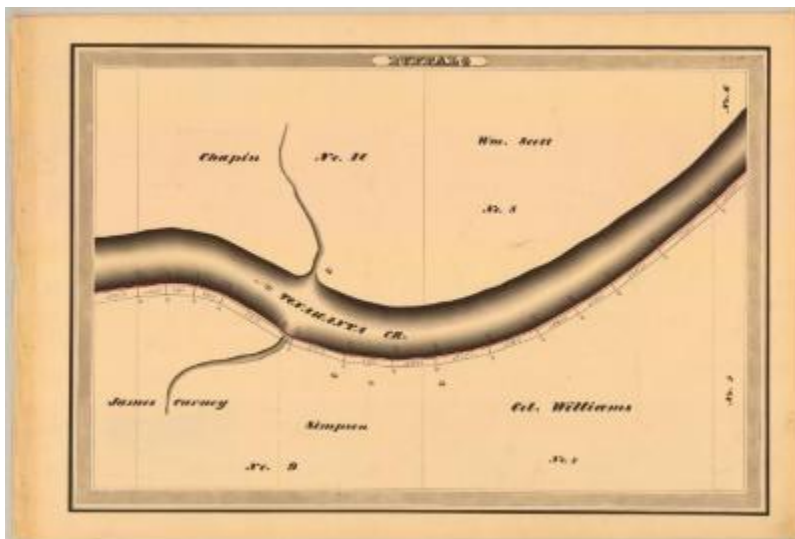


Erie Canal Survey, Buffalo showing Carney and Scott
