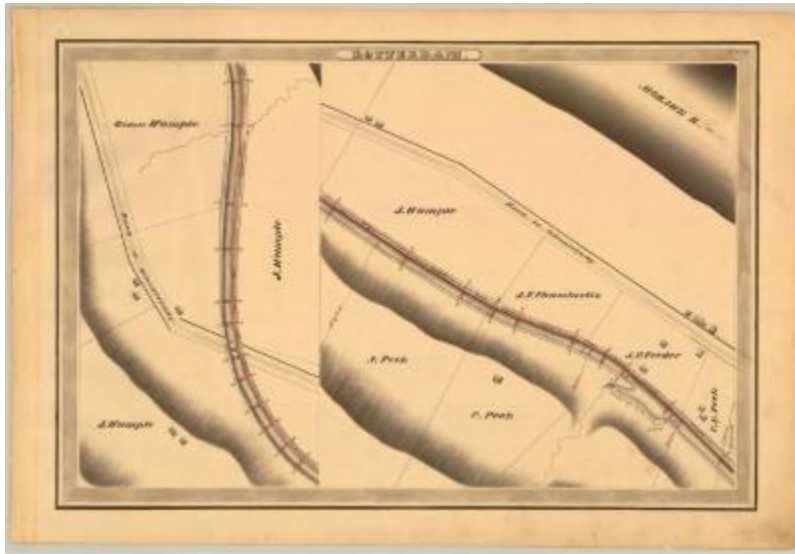


Erie Canal Survey, Rotterdam showing two views of Canal and Road to Schenectady
