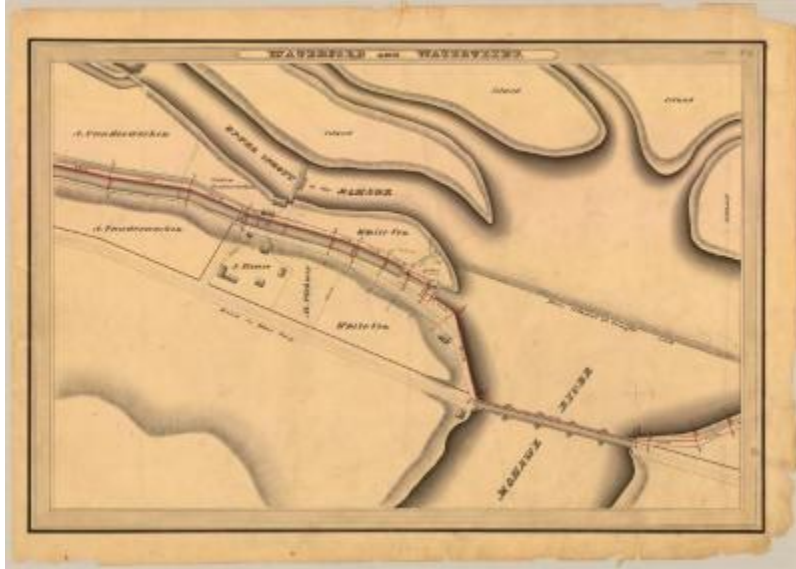


Champlain Canal Survey, Waterford and Watervliet showing Upper Sprout of Mohawk, Dam and Islands



This is an ink, wash and charcoal map of a section of the Champlain Canal in Waterford and Watervliet. It shows the Upper Sprout of the Mohawk River, the point where the Mohawk River branches into five separate channels, two dams, four islands, three bridges including one that spans the Mohawk, ten buildings and the Road to West Troy. The red lines indicate courses and distances. The blue lines indicate canal right-of-way. The map also shows the properties of White and Company, A. Vanderworken, Widow Vanderworken, J. Hollse and M. Tickner.

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
