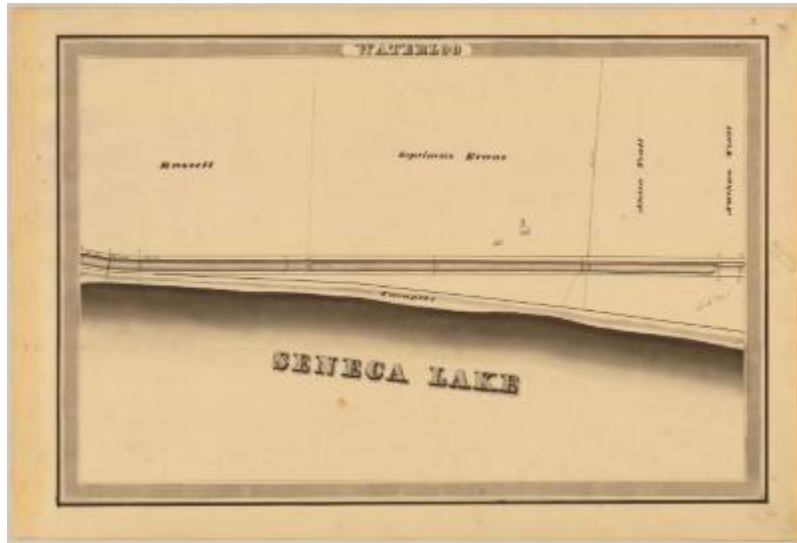


## Cayuga and Seneca Canal Survey, Waterloo showing Turnpike and Seneca Lake
