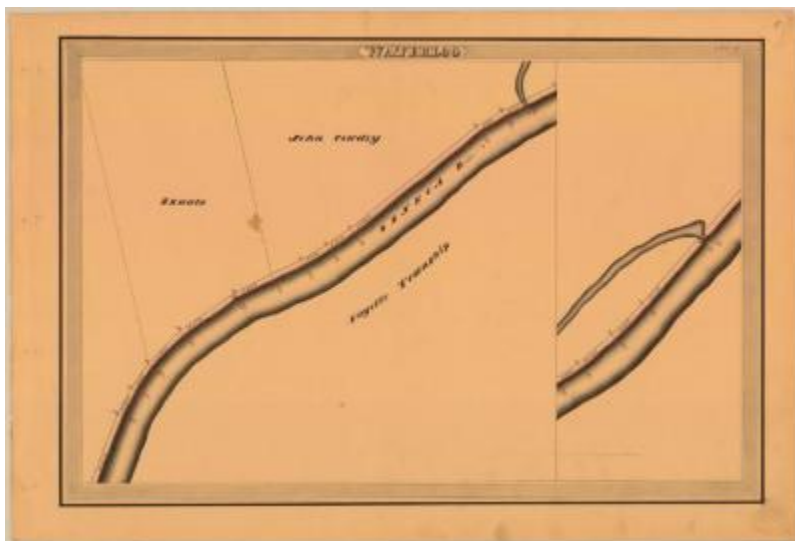


Cayuga and Seneca Canal Survey, Waterloo showing two views of Seneca River
