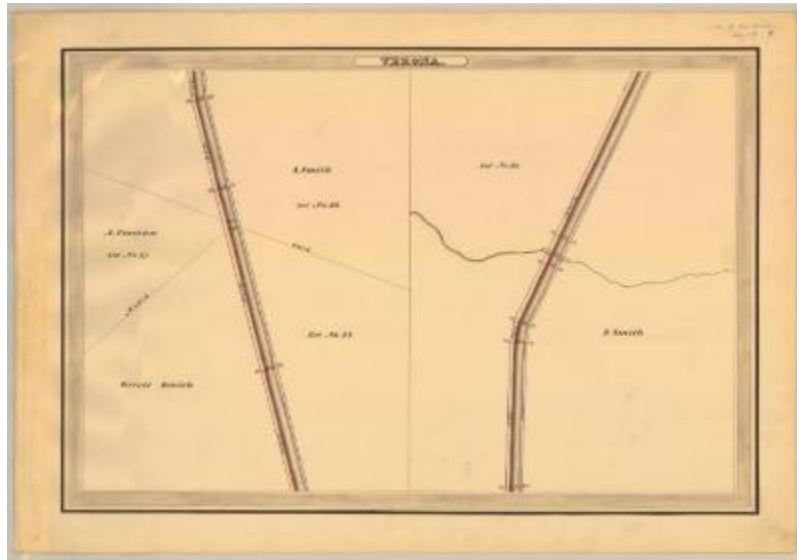


Erie Canal Survey, Verona showing Smith and Vroman
