Amsterdam. Letter. Directors of the W. I. Company at Amsterdam to (director Stuyvesant) ; samples of minerals from N. Netherland ; peace with the Indians ; handsome villages and buildings around fort Amsterdam ; English to be permitted to settle in N. N., but their magistrates to be appointed by the director ; iron mine on Staten island ; English trading house near Fort Orange; more negroes to be sent to N. Netherland, &c. [1646]
