Amsterdam. Letter. Directors to Stuyvesant ; Jews to have same privileges as in Holland, except religious liberty ; expedition against the Swedes approved ; Indian raid on New Amsterdam ; relief to the sufferers ; Cornelis and Adriaen van Tienhoven dismissed ; Sille, fiscal ; Hartford treaty approved by States-General ; encouragement to emigrants.
