Amsterdam. Letter. Directors to Stuyvesant ; embassy to demand some Christian children from the Indians in the name of the States-General ; vice-director La Montagne ; a block house to be erected on the borders of New England and a redoubt at Esopus ; city's colonie on the South river ; director Alrichs ; tenths ; French privateer at New Amsterdam ; records of New Netherland ; trade with Curaçao.
