The Factory Investigating Commission's Individual Annual Earnings data card for Frank Sanderson, a box maker at Knickerbocker Chocolate, a candy factory in New York City. The card lists the establishment number; the employee number; the employee's name, address, occupation, age, and gender; the employee's rate of pay, weekly earnings, and annual earnings; and the weeks, days, and hours the employee worked during the year commencing September 26, 1912. During the fifty-two weeks he worked during the year, Mr. Sanderson earned an average of \$14.17 per week at the rates of \$13.00 and \$14.00 for a sixty-hour week.
