View of a New York State game protector examining a ring-necked pheasant (*Phasianus colchicus*) chick raised by a 4-H club for release into the wild. The young man is presumably a member of the club, which may be the Rensselaer County chapter. The date is unrecorded, but may be July 1931. Pheasants are indigenous to Asia. This image was created to record the game-related activities of the New York State Conservation Department.
