Civil War muster roll abstract for New York volunteer Harrison Clark. The extended remarks on the abstract indicate his remarkable service record, from being promoted at the Battle of Gettysburg to being wounded and having his leg amputated at the Battle of the Wilderness. Clark was awarded a medal of honor for distinguished service at the Battle of Gettysburg.
