


## List of required edits for Battleship Potemkin



Better known as "Battleship Potemkin," the film's official title upon release was "The Armored Cruiser Prince Potemkin." The censor who viewed the film prior to its release called for the elimination of specific scenes that they deemed to be "inhuman" or would "tend to incite to crime."
