

Indian deed from the chiefs of Keskaechquerem of a tract of land on Long Island



Indian deed from the chiefs of Keskaechquerem [likely members of the Canarsee, a group that was part of the Lenape], of a tract of land on Long Island, running east from George Rapalje's plantation to Mespaehtes, a full league and a half, and in breadth about one league from the East river.
