Patent. Jan Cornelissen Crynnen; 25 morgens of land across the North river, between Gemoenepae and the Kil van Kol; 17 April, 1664, this grantee being deceased, the above land was granted to Isaac de Foreest, who had previously purchased the same from Jan Crynnen (New Jersey).
