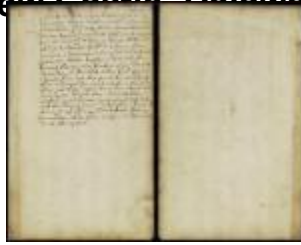


Patent of Thomas Broen for a plantation on the South river, below Fort Casimir (New Castle, Delaware)
