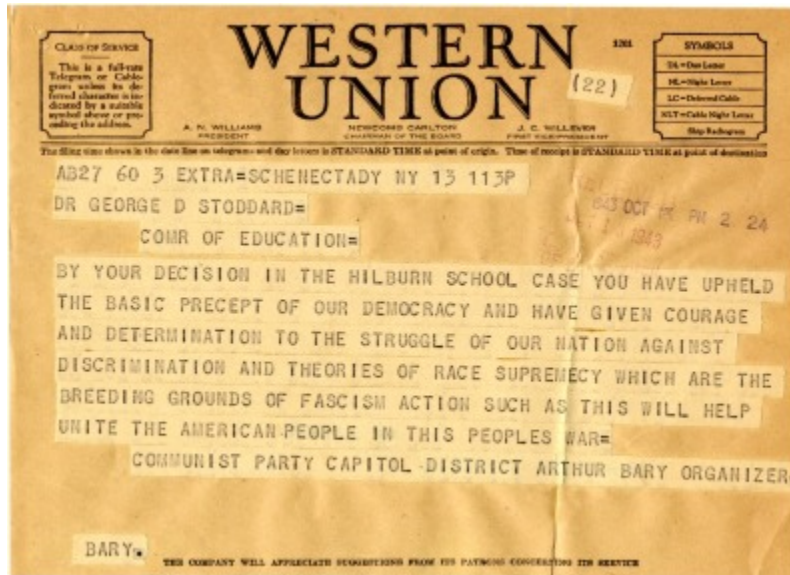


Telegram from Arthur Bary, Communist Party of the Capitol [Capital] District, to New York State Commissioner of Education Dr. George D. Stoddard
