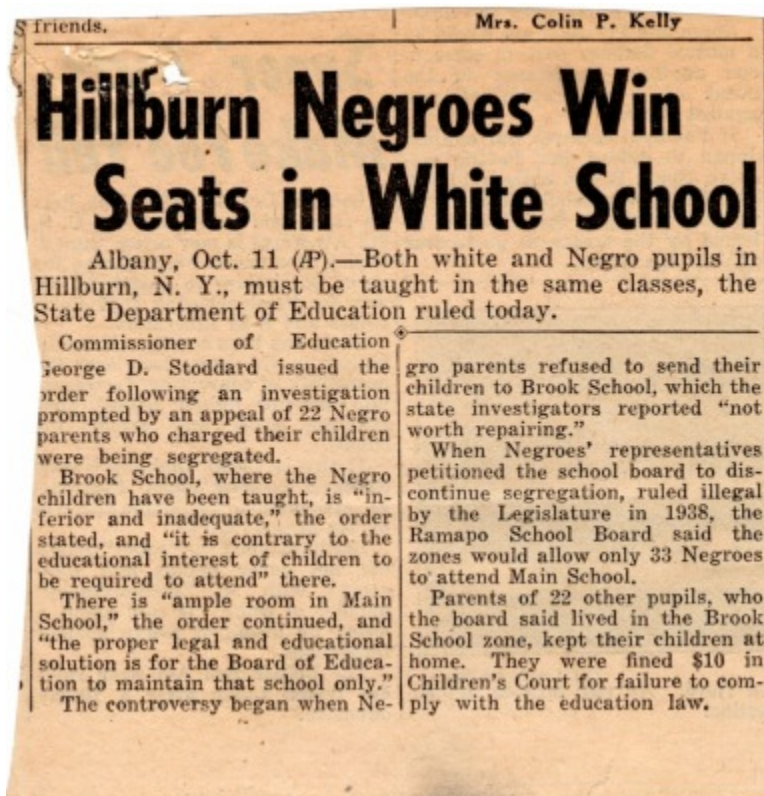


Newspaper clipping, "Hillburn Negroes Win Seats in White School"
