

Dedication plaque on bench at Saratoga Battlefield



This is the back of a bench which accompanies a memorial to the unknown soldiers who died at Saratoga Battlefield. It bears the names of the organizations that paid for it: the New York State Officer's Club and the Daughters of the American Revolution. The Battles of Saratoga occurred on September 19 and October 7, 1777, and are considered the turning point of the American Revolution. This image was created to record the historic site activities of the New York State Conservation Department.
