A field of young Norway Spruce (*Picea abies*), intended for use as Christmas trees, are growing on this plantation in Livingston County. The field is maintained by the Civilian Conservation Corps, camp S-117, stationed in Birdsall, N.Y. This image was created to record the reforestation work of the Civilian Conservation Corps under the supervision of the New York State Conservation Department.
