

Waterhole, St. Lawrence County



This waterhole was constructed by the Civilian Conservation Corps, camp S-95, stationed in Brasher Falls. The crew excavated a hole and lined it with stone to form a receptacle for water drawn from a spring. It will serve as a source of water during firefighting efforts. This image was created to record the reforestation work of the Civilian Conservation Corps under the supervision of the New York State Conservation Department.
