1. In addition to the customary questions with respect to
juror's residence, employment and family status, it is requested
that each juror be asked whether he/she, or any member of their
family, has been employed by or affiliated (i.e., any of the following
organizations) and the nature of such associations:

1. Local police, sheriff's department, State Police, military
reserve or other law enforcement agencies.
2. Any prison, detention center, jail, or custody facility
where persons are confined against their will.
3. Any association where a voluntary or public organization
concerned with prisoners' rights, minority rights, the
administration or prevention of police or law enforcement
brutality and the rights of crime victims.
4. Private, voluntary or public agency dedicated to or
working for reform of police, law enforcement or other
branches of government.
5. News media in any form, particularly with respect to the
collection and publication of new items.
6. Has the Juror or any member of his/her family had any
personal experience with any of the following and the nature of?
