JOSHUA J. EFFRON, an attorney at law duly licensed to practice
before this Court does hereby affirm:

1. I am trial counsel to Gurda, Gurda, Lynch and Smith,
attorneys of record for the late John W. Norahan and for John S.
Keller, appointed administrator of Major Norahan's estate. I am
familiar with the facts in this case. I make this supplemental
affirmation in support of defendant's motion for an amendment of
this Court's order of February 22, 1993 to include a certification
pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1292-b to permit an application to be made
to the Second Circuit, and also in opposition to plaintiff's motion
for Rule 11, F.R.C.P., sanctions.

2. This Court, by scheduling order dated May 4, 1993 (copy
attached), directed plaintiffs to file responsive papers by May 28,
1993. As of this date no papers have been received from the
plaintiffs addressing our motion of April 26, 1993. Plaintiffs
have however, filed a motion de novo seeking Rule 11, F.R.C.P.
sanctions. We believe there is no basis in law for plaintiffs
motion and ask that it be denied in all respects.

3. The basic question in this case, as it pertains to the
