WRVR journalist Dan Mack summarizes testimony. McKay swears in Edward Young, an Attica inmate. General Counsel Arthur Liman examines Young. Follow-up questions are asked by Commission members McKay and Henix. Young makes a final statement. Witness is excused. Mack summarizes testimony. McKay swears in Sowell, an inmate at Attica. Willis examines Sowell.
